## Blue Box (containers)

- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Aluminum plates
- Cardboard cans (frozen juice, peanuts, etc.)
- Cartons (milk, juice, cream)
- Coffee cup lids (Tim Hortons)
- Egg cartons (plastic)
- Glass bottles & jars (non-refundable, lids removed)
- Juice boxes
- Paint cans (METAL, empty, dry, lids removed)
- Plastic clam shell packaging (bakery & produce)
- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs & lids (i.e. food & beverage containers, household cleaning products, laundry detergent, shampoo bottles, etc.)
- Pop/juice cans
- Small scrap metal items (utensils, pots & pans, baking sheets, metal coat hangers)
- Steel cans
- Yogurt/pudding/applesauce cups



### \*\* These items are not recyclable:

- Flower pots/trays
- Blister packaging
- Chip bags
- Candy wrappers

**Ashes** - Please dispose of ashes in the specified area at your waste site or watch local papers for curbside pickup dates
